
How to add an Emoji to Ancestor's Profiles on Ancestry.com or MyHeritage.com

Here are some simple tricks to customize the visualization of your family tree on Ancestry.com or MyHeritage.com. This trick cannot be done on FindMyPast or FamilySearch. This allows the emojis to show in the tree view.



Steps for Ancestry (MyHeritage is similar)

- > Open the profile of your ancestor.
- ➢ Go to the Facts Tab
- Name and Gender
- ➢ Hover over the primary name and choose Edit
- > Copy the Emoji you want from this handout or from Emojipedia.com
- Paste the Emoji into the <u>SUFFIX field only</u>. (Do not put it in any other field or it will mess up the search function!)
