Before the interview put a star or number next to the most important questions that you need answered first, in case you run out of time or the interviewee runs out of energy.

Below are suggestions to ask. Feel free to improvise. You are looking for information and items that help tell your ancestors life story. Put a priority on when and where for life events such as birth, marriage, and death... and copy/photograph documents whenever possible. In some cases, you might start with a tree chart so you're clear on who is who in the family structure.

When you get home, polish your notes immediately and catalog everything you acquired along with noting where you got the information/artifacts/documents.
