In Memory of Corps. Clifford Henley and Roy Kirkpatrick, Who Fell in France.
Memorial services for two of our brave lads, who sacrificed their lives in the recent war, will be held at the Methodist church at 3 o'clock Sunday afternoon, the sermon to be delivered by Rev. DeYoe. Clifford was the son of Mr. and Mrs. H. G. Henley, and was killed in action September 29, in the Argonne Forest, where he and others were cut off from the main body and went five days without food and water. Roy was the son of Mr. and Mrs. James Kirkpatrick, and was killed in action on October 10, although there are no particulars.

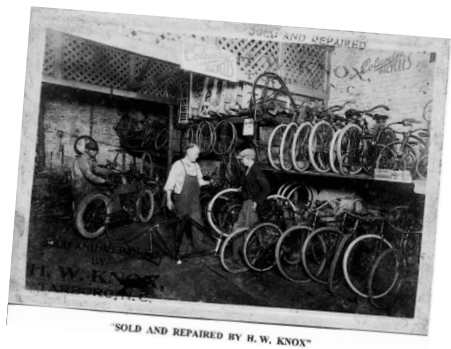
