

Tallie E. Davis Dies Suddenly

**Plymouth Native Was Sales
Agent for Atlantic Coal
Company**

Tallie E. Davis, 56, brother of David T. Davis, state mine inspector of this city, died suddenly on Friday of a heart attack at Medford, Mass., according to word received on Saturday by local relatives.

Mr. Davis was born in Plymouth and was educated in the public school of that borough and Wyoming Seminary. He was the son of the late Jenkin and Elizabeth Davis, early settlers of the West Side. For many years he resided on High Street, Plymouth.

Starting his career in the coal business with Conyngham and Company he later became sales manager of the Susquehanna Collieries Company at Nanticoke.

For the last 20 years Mr. Davis had been employed in the sales division of the Atlantic Coal Company with headquarters at Medford, Mass. Before settling in that city he resided for several years in Buffalo, N. Y. He was one of Medford's prominent residents and served for several years as chairman of the council in that city. He was affiliated with various organizations and took part in all civic enterprises of Medford.

Surviving are his widow, Theresa, and four children, Richard, a student at Harvard University; Eugene, a student at Massachusetts Tech; Elizabeth, a student at La Salle College, and Charlotte, at home, and two brothers, David T. Davis of this city and Evor Davis, superintendent of Plymouth Mining Company.

Mr. and Mrs. D. T. Davis and Evor Davis left on Saturday for Medford, where they will attend the funeral services on Monday afternoon. Burial will be at Medford.
