- Which John Henley, is my John Henley in 1840 Census?
 - Target Ancestor
 - John Henley, 1793-1854
 - Wife Margaret 1794-1865
 - Challenges
 - 1850 is the last census that named household members.
 - 1790-1840 Only Tick Marks for others, besides HOH.

- Probate Package for John Henley dated 1856. Names all children.



US Census Enumeration Dates for **Population Schedules**

1790-1840 only names the head of household. Other members of the residence were counted with tick marks in age columns. Beginning in 1850, every white family member was named. Beginning in 1870 all persons regardless of race, were named in the census.









Timeline for John Henley Records
